



TENANT APPRENTICE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

TIMELINE

Applications due:	15 th July (3 x up to \$1,000 scholarships available)
	15 th February (3 x up to \$1,000 scholarships available)
Decision notified:	ASAP after Board approval
Funding released:	On receipt of appropriate evidence of costs

TOTAL AVAILABLE FUNDS

A maximum of six scholarships per annum, of up to \$1,000 each.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

MTLT will offer six scholarships per annum of up to \$1,000 each to apprentices employed by MTLT tenants. The funds will be used to meet fees associated with apprenticeship training. This recognises the contribution MTLT tenants make to employing and supporting local people in apprentice training, and their contribution to the community through the lease of community-owned property.

Criteria:

- The applicant must be an apprentice employed by a MTLT tenant.
- Applications are open to all apprentices employed by a MTLT tenant, however, preference will be given to those applicants who currently reside or have been educated within the Trust district. A detailed map of the Trust district can be found at www.mtl.org.nz/about-us/trust-district.
- The applicant must be a New Zealand citizen or resident.
- The applicant must not be eligible to receive any Government “free fees” funding in the year the scholarship is applied for.
- The applicant must submit a fully completed application form together with supporting letter.

Conditions:

- Scholarship funds must be used towards Industry Training Organisation fees only.
- The scholarship funds will be paid upon receipt of appropriate evidence of costs, e.g. invoice/receipt from Industry Training Organisation.
- The recipient agrees to participate in the promotion of the scholarship through involvement in publicity on the MTLT website, in the news media and other material.
- No person can receive the scholarship more than once.
- The scholarship will be awarded solely at the discretion of the selectors (MTLT trustees).
